

## **The life of George Dannatt (1793 – 1853)**

(compiled by Eliz. Thacker – March 2000)

1793 Sept 25th      George, son of Michael and Ann Dannatt (nee Cusson) baptised at All Saints Church, Belton.

1818 Mar 16th      George marries Hannah Leggott at Luddington Parish Church.

1821 Sept 16th      Son, Thomas, baptised at All Saints Church, Belton.

1824 May 23rd      Son, George, baptised at All Saints Church, Belton.

\*1825 Sept 10th      Daughter, Mary, baptised at All Saints Church, Belton.

\*1826 Dec 17th      Daughter, Mary, baptised at All Saints Church, Belton.

1827 Jul 1st      Son, Michael, baptised at All Saints Church, Belton.

\*1828 Aug 10th      Daughter, Mary, baptised at All Saints Church, Belton.

Note: Only one Mary survives to adulthood. I found no deaths in this period for Mary Dannatt. I can only assume that a death was wrongly entered in the baptism, rather than the burial register. This, I am assured, does happen occasionally.

1841 Census	George and Hannah, along with John, Thomas, Mary and Michael are living in Belton, I cannot be certain they are all at the same address as there were some amendments to the census that I cannot read. As I have not yet found a baptism relating to John I cannot yet assume him as George and Hannah's son.
1851 Census	George and Hannah are living at Hag Lane, Belton. His daughter Mary (25) and son Michael (23) are still at home. George's occupation is "Farmer of 8 Acres".
1853 June 29th	Burial of George Dannatt age 60 at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
