1739 Jul 12th	Baptism of Michael Dannatt, son of Thomas (Thos) Dannatt at Laughton by Gainsborough, Lincs.
1768 May 12th	Michael Dannatt marries Elizabeth Womack at Epworth Parish Church, Lincolnshire.
1769 May 3rd	Baptism of daughter, Ann at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1770 Sep 25th	BaptIsm of son, Thomas at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1771 Dec 27th	Baptism of daughter, Elizabeth at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1774 Jul 22nd	Baptism of daughter, Mary at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1776 Dec 2nd	Baptism of daughter, Erances at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1779 Mar 28th	Baptism of daughter, Sarah at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1780 Sep 25th	Baptism of daughter Rebecca at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1783 May 24th	Baptism of daughter, Jane at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.

1783 May 28th	Burial of Elizabeth Dannatt at All Saints Parish Church, four days after the baptism of her daughter Jane. {There was also a son Michael born to Michael and Ellzabeth, I have not yet found his baptism.)
1784 Mar 19th	Burial of Jane, daughter of Michael and Elizabeth at All Saints Parish Church, Belton. This has been a tragic year for Michael.
1787 Sep 12th	Michael marries his second wife, Ann Cusson at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1788 Sep 25th	Baptism of Michael, son of Michael and Ann at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1789 Jul 5th	Baptism of Martha at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1790 May 28th	Burial of Michael, son of Michael and Elizabeth at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1791 Apr 24th	Baptism of Sarah at All Saints Parish Church, Belton
1793 Sept 25th	Baptism of George at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.
1808 Apr 4th	Burial- of Michael Dannatt at All Saints Parish Church, Belton.

N.B. I have relied solely on Parish Records for the details of Michael's life as Registration of Birth, Marriages and Deaths was not introduced till 1837. More research needs to be carried out as he probably had more children, possibly baptised at Epworth.
